## **S.C.O.R.E.**

### **Supporting Children's Opportunities in Recreational Events**

**Policy** – The Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Department has a limited number of S.C.O.R.E. Scholarships available for children who wish to participate in classes, programs, or sports leagues offered by the City of Santa Clarita. The maximum amount of any scholarship awarded shall not exceed \$101. Additional costs (i.e., material fees, uniforms, etc.) over and above the initial registration fee are not included. Day Camps, Excursions, and Special Events are not currently covered under this scholarship program. All scholarships, regardless of need, are limited to the donated funds that are available.

**Eligibility** – Any resident of the Santa Clarita Valley is eligible to apply for a scholarship for a child (17 years of age and under) in their immediate family. Full and partial scholarships are awarded to children based on family size and parent's income level. Scholarships are limited to one (1) per season, per child.

#### **Application Process**

1. Fill out the attached S.C.O.R.E application (one form per child). All applications and information will be kept strictly confidential.

**Note: A copy of your most recent federal income tax return (or other proof of income) is required in order for your application to be reviewed.**

2. Fill out the appropriate registration form for the class or youth sports program in which you wish your child to participate in. Registration forms are located in the Seasons brochure.
3. Submit your S.C.O.R.E. application, class or youth sports program registration form, along with proof of income by the filing period listed on the previous page. **Keep in mind that all scholarships are issued on a first-come, first-served, funds available basis.**
4. Your application will be processed and reviewed for approval. During this time, we will hold a roster spot for your child in the class or program you have requested. If the class/program you have requested is full, you will be placed on a waitlist.
5. You will be notified of the status of your application by mail. Scholarships are awarded on either a full or partial basis for a maximum amount of \$101, and are limited to the funds that are available. If your child is awarded a full scholarship, you will receive confirmation along with a registration receipt indicating the enrollment. If your child is awarded a partial scholarship, he or she will remain on "hold" until the remaining balance is paid to the City of Santa Clarita. This balance must be paid prior to the child attending the class/program.
