THE WRITING

Students are encouraged to write about the life of the cowboy and cowgirl, the settlement of the West, life on the open range, or cowgirls and cowboys of the future. Poetry should rhyme or be in rhymed couplets and tell a story in the historic oral narrative tradition.

THE RULES

One poem per student submitted with entry form. Poems must be **one page only**, legibly printed or typed, and double-spaced. Categories for City of Santa Clarita student submissions are: Grades 1 - 3; 4 - 6; 7 - 9; or 10 - 13. Entries become property of the City of Santa Clarita. (City of Santa Clarita employees and their families are ineligible.) Contest deadline is **March 29, 2010**.

All trophies will be awarded for each of the four categories at the 17th Annual Cowboy Festival
