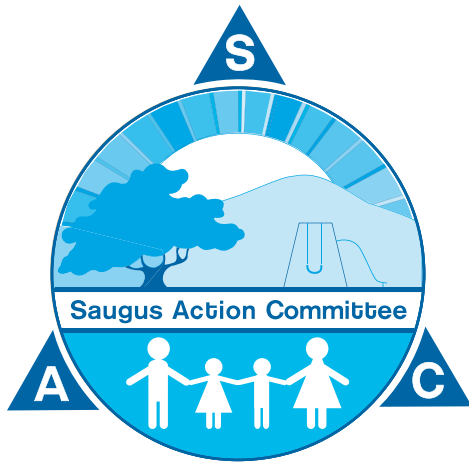

## Beautification

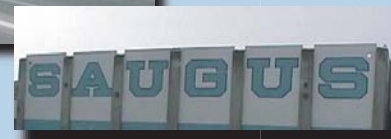

## Haskell Canyon Bridge Widening and Beautification



Started in 1999, the Saugus Action Committee was formed to articulate the particular concerns of the Saugus community. To date, the committee has been very successful in securing beautification along the major thoroughfares, park planning, and traffic improvement, all of which answered to the major concerns raised during the 1999 community survey. Specific improvements have been the median/shoulder landscaping along Bouquet and Seco Canyon roads, the widening of the Haskell Canyon Bridge and tree planting, and park design at both Central and Pamplico parks.

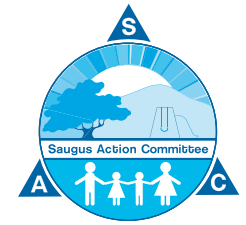
