Reminders

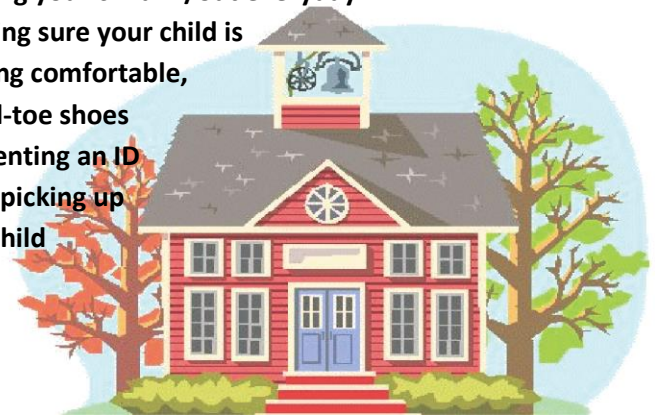
We will be very busy this month establishing our routine, getting to know our classroom rules, and becoming familiar with our surroundings. Please help us keep everyone safe by:

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Alphabet	Letters Aa and Bb
Reading Readiness	Sounds, tracing, and writing of letters A and B. Name recognition and tracing.
Math	Counting to ten, learning to identify and write the number 1.
People and Places	Meeting our new friends and teachers, exploring our classroom, bathrooms, and playground.
Science	Identifying the parts of an apple and looking at our fingerprints with magnifying glasses.
Health and Nutrition	Stressing the importance of hand-washing and covering our sneezes.
Safety and Environment	Learning our classroom, playground, and bathroom rules.
Music Appreciation	“Good Morning”, “Days of the Week”, “A Little Red Apple”.
Fine and Gross Motor Skills	Fine: learning correct pencil, scissor, and tweezer grips. Gross: stacking blocks, yoga poses, ball rolling.
Special Days and Events	Please turn in “All About Me” share bags by September 12/13, so we can begin sharing with our classmates. Picture day is September 24/25 at 8:30 a.m.
Dramatic Play	Mirrors, apple stand with cash register, making pretend apple pies
