



## 2020 Summer Youth Basketball

### General Information - *Please Read Carefully!*

1. Special requests such as carpooling, coaches, friends, etc., **will not** be considered for any division except Pee Wee (ages 4-5) and Mighty Mite (ages 6-7) due to the drafting process. These requests are not guaranteed.
2. Parents who are interested in coaching, but did not indicate so on the participant's registration form may call (661) 250-3756. All volunteer coaches are required to be fingerprinted
3. Selected coaches will have a mandatory meeting for Pee Wee, Mighty Mite and Junior divisions on Tuesday, June 2, 2020, at 6:30 p.m., and for Minor, Major, and Senior divisions on Wednesday, June 3, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. Coaches will receive schedules, equipment, and jerseys, which will then be distributed to the participants. Volunteers who are selected to coach will be notified prior to the coaches meeting.
4. A coach will notify you no later than Wednesday, June 15, 2020. **Please do not call prior to this date to find out the name of your coach.**
5. Please bring with you to the assessments a birth certificate, passport, or some form of birthdate identification.
6. Practices may begin the week of June 15, 2020. Practices are at the discretion of the coach. Indoor practice times will not be assigned. All Girls, Major, and Senior Divisions will be in a mixed area league, which may result in your coach holding practices outside of your residential area. **If your child is absolutely unable to attend the assigned practice time, you will be given a refund. We will not be able to switch your child to another team.**
7. Games will be played on Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. beginning **Saturday, June 20, 2020**. There may be an occasional weeknight game. The season will end approximately August 22, 2020.
8. The wearing of any type of jewelry during participation is prohibited.
9. Uniforms will consist of a jersey only. You will be responsible for purchasing your child's shorts.
10. The City does not carry insurance for participants in the Youth Sports Program.
11. Full refunds are granted prior to the coaches meeting. A \$14 fee will be assessed once teams have been formed. Refunds will not be granted after the second game of the season.
12. **All registered and wait listed participants MUST be assessed to be drafted to a team.** If your child is unable to attend player assessments, they will be considered a "Hat Pick" and be randomly placed on a team. Coaches select teams based on an open draft. Schedule of player assessments are as follows for the following drafted divisions (excludes Mighty Mite and Pee Wee divisions):
