March 9-13: T is for Transportation

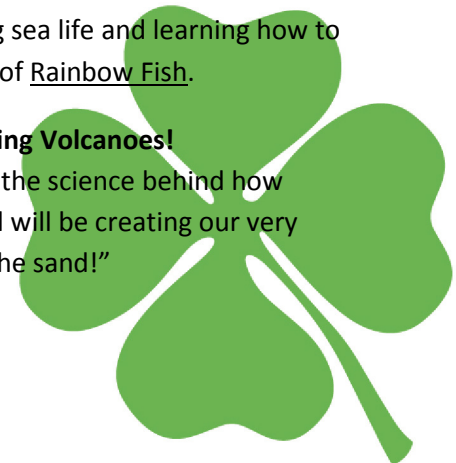
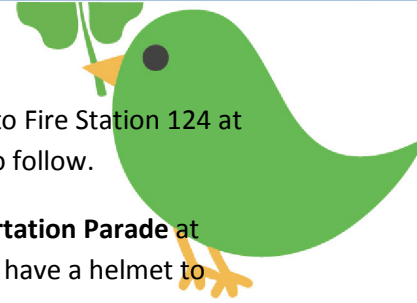
We will explore vehicles on the go and make our very own license plates!
